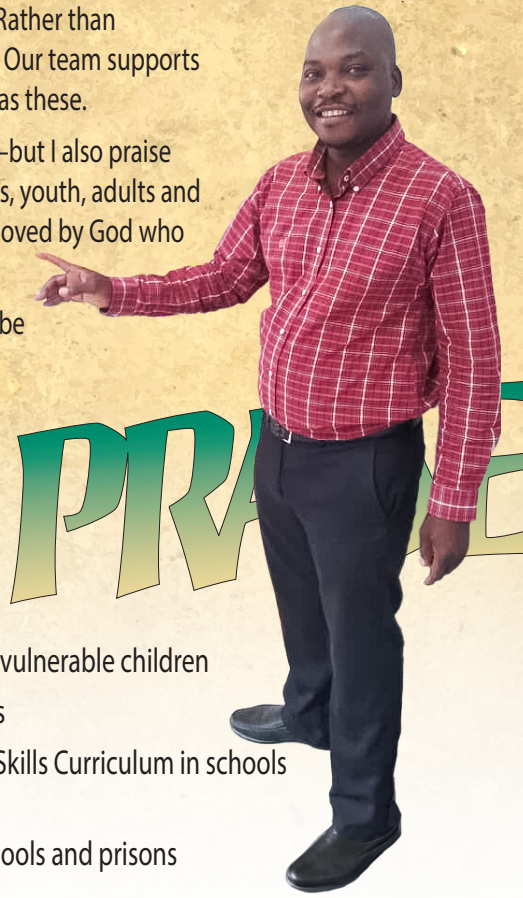

(Sub-Saharan Africa Family Enrichment)

1. **Gogo Grandmothers** (grandparents) caring for orphans and vulnerable children
2. **Early Childhood Development** through village preschools
3. **Education & Youth Development** (8-year Why Wait? Life Skills Curriculum in schools and at SAFE Haven Youth Center)
4. **Evangelism and Discipleship** throughout in villages, schools and prisons

2,500 children were enrolled in SAFE's 20 village preschools. 92 teachers, 44 cooks and 20 storytellers surrounded these children with God's love and truth and the joy of learning.

Praise: Being a CBCC cook has enabled her to pay my children's school fees and buy fertilizer and seed for their food security.

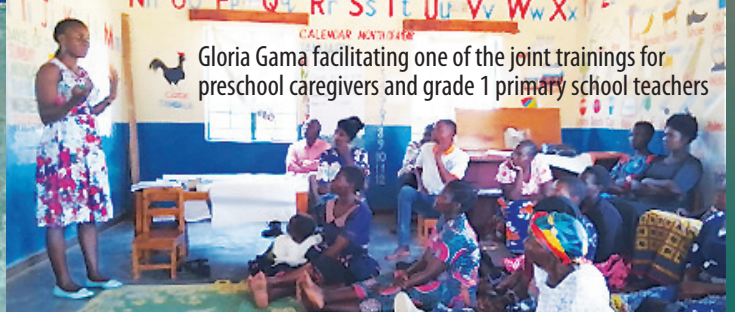

IMPACT: 450,000 meals served to preschool children due to SAFE's fertilizer program for gogos. They share part of their harvest to feed the children.

SAFE has some of the best-trained, long-serving preschool teachers in Malawi because we pay a small allowance to help provide for their own families.

626 village children graduated to primary school equipped socially, spiritually, and educationally to be lifelong learners.

PRAYER POINT

There is a food crisis in Malawi. 892 gogos will need 25kg of maize each month, January thru March. (1 gogo/3 months \$75 or 1 month \$25)



Voices of praise from 2,257 gogos who received the extra materials they needed to make their Mbeya compost fertilizer!



IMPACT: ■ 36 homes are being built for gogos who lost their homes in Cyclone Freddy.

■ 2257 gogos in 12 communities received training & materials for Mbeya fertilizer composting.

■ Even with a poor harvest gogos gave maize to the CBCCs to help make porridge for the children.

■ 2,313 gogos watched films: *Magdalena & Walking w/Jesus.*

I am Gogo Iness, and I **PRAISE** God that when we were sick from malaria, you sent **SAFE** to give us mosquito nets, and when we were cold they gave us blankets. Now they are constructing Gogo homes destroyed by Cyclone Freddy. **SAFE** is training us to make compost manure so we can feed ourselves and the children in our **SAFE** village preschools. 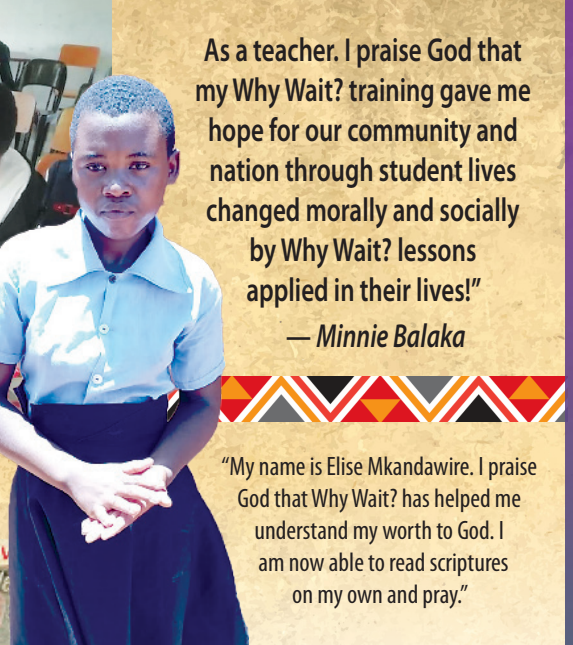


Experiencing the power of discussion and interactive learning

- IMPACT:** ■ 45 schools implement WW?. 11 new schools will be added soon.
- 185 teachers are reaching 11,266 students
 - Why Wait? teachers also mentor SAFE's bursary students who can't afford school fees. 100% passed their Malawi School Certificate of Education examinations this year.

IMPACT: ■ 140 Chichewa Bibles distributed. ■ 1,249 students watched *The Story of Jesus for Children* film. ■ 2,313 gogos watched the *Walking with Jesus* or *Magdalena* films. ■ Going door-to-door, 45 people accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior. ■ 420 chiefs and spouses came for prayers and to see 2 of the *Walking With Jesus* films. ■ 60 inmates from 2 prisons attended the Evangelism and Discipleship training.

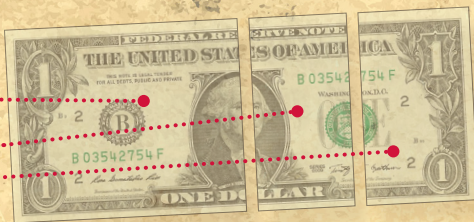

- Gogos & Early Childhood Development Programs
- Education, Youth Development & Evangelism Programs
- Administration & Operations in Malawi



Gogo Grandmothers

- 2,378 Registered gogos from 13 communities
- 2,257 Gogos received materials for fertilizer composting
- 36 Houses constructed for gogos affected by Cyclone Freddy
- 17 Students rescued from entering an early marriage and returned to school

Early Childhood Development

- 20 CBCCs (preschools)
- 2,500 Children enrolled
- 92 Trained preschool teachers
- 44 Cooks
- 626 Children graduated to Primary Schools from the 20 CBCCs

Education and Youth Development

- 185 Why Wait? teachers trained & classrooms monitored
- 45 Schools presently implementing Why Wait?
- 11,266 Students reached with Why Wait? lessons
- 1,000 WW? books distributed
- 5 Students receiving secondary school fees passed key Malawi School Certificate Exam

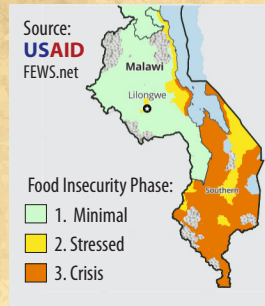
- 94 People trained in Evangelism and Discipleship

A-maize-ing Rescue... Because Cyclone Freddy destroyed crops, and fertilizer has become scarce and very expensive, there is a real food crisis in Southern Malawi (see map). To survive, 892 of our registered village gogos will need 25kg of maize each month, January thru March. Supplying one gogo family for 3 months costs \$75 (\$25 per month). 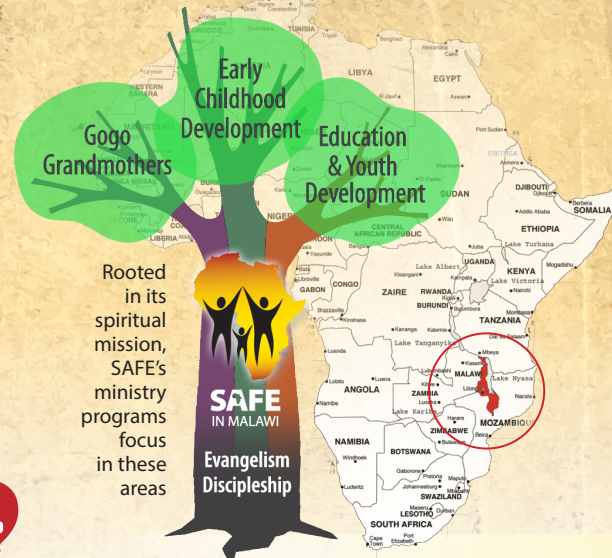

Why Wait? in Schools... Continue the expansion of Why Wait? Life-Skills Curriculum into 11 more schools. 145 teachers will be trained—including 45 new teachers. Approximately 13,000 more students will have the opportunity to form a biblical worldview—to become wise in their decisions and relationships, and servant leaders in their communities.
